Bugs fixed:

- 1.) Have a valid configuration with ASCII data type. Deleting and re-adding the String in "Fields" list will cause an Error.

- 2.) Possible to have Database option available in PLC configuration window in Trial Mode.
- 3.) With DoMore option selected the "Start PACKETOUT Location" returns to V0 if another user assigned starting address is used other than V0 upon re-edit of PLC configuration.
- 4.) If you try to add more than one field at the same time in PLC configuration 'Fields' list the software crashes and then closes.

- 1) Added support for the Do-More plc.

- 1) Fixed issues with the Pending Diagnostic function.
