All the production of components, sub assemblies and finished products are made by Reer SpA in accordance Directive 2011/65/EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS - Restriction of Hazardous Substances), recast of the previous Directive 2002/95/EC and subsequent amendments introduced by the Delegated Directive 2015/863/EU.

The company Reer S.p.A. furthermore declares that:

- Each product by Reer S.p.A. will continue to comply with the requirements of all applicable directives, including if necessary the RoHS Directive.
- Our products already included in the previous Directive or falling under RoHS for the first time, as a result of the inclusion of the new category 11 or any changes exclusions or applications exempted, will respond to the requirements according to the dates indicated by the Directive.
- The parts supplied by us, while respecting the principle of induced conformity, will ensure the maintenance of compliance of the finished product within which they have to be incorporated.
- The products supplied by us are made, without containing substances with restrictions of use as per article 4, paragraph 1, and maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials referred to the Annex II of the Directive.

Based on the above statements, Reer S.p.A. maintains all the necessary actions in order to ensure the continuity of the supply chain and in particular: the updating of the necessary information concerning the evolution of the RoHS Directive, the search for alternative suppliers in order to ensure continuity of supply, the research and the development of alternative substances and processes to ensure customer continuity, quality and performance of its products.
