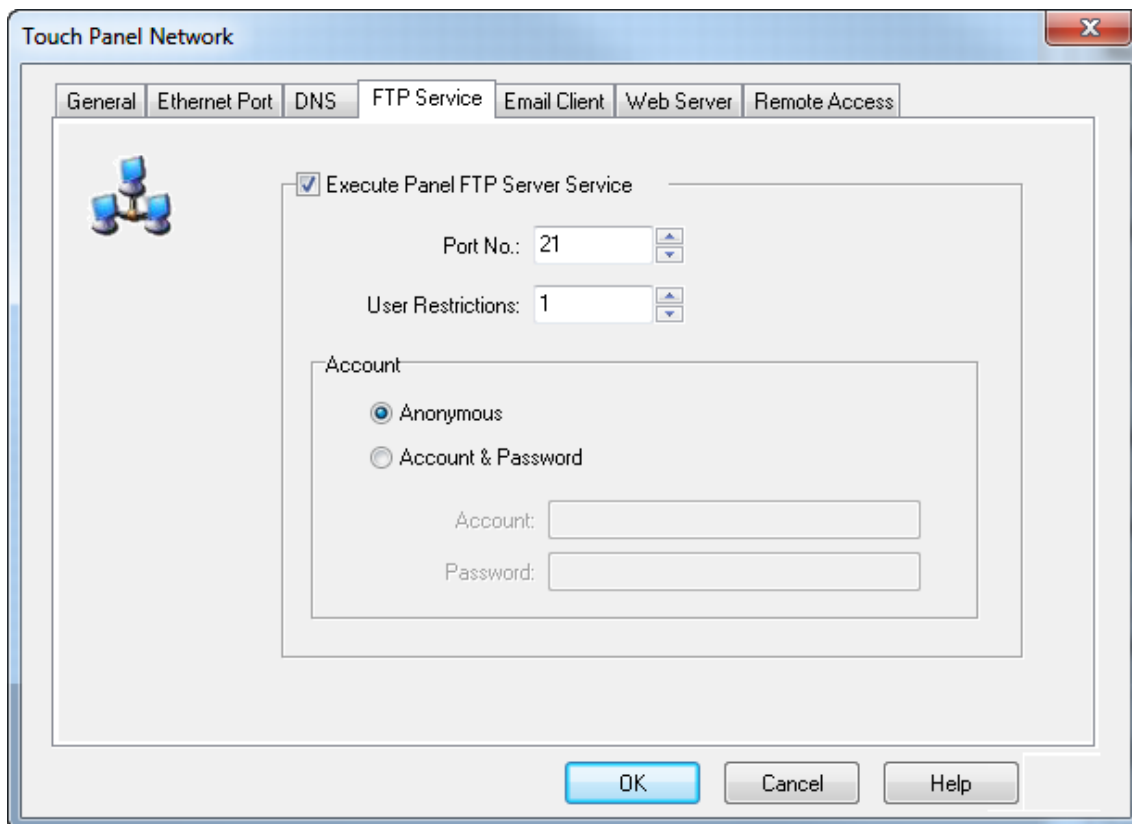

Editing the HTML files in the C-more Panel

In order to edit the HTML files in the C-more panel, the files must be copied from the panel to a local drive and edited with a Text Editor application like Notepad.

The files in the C-more Panel are accessed via FTP. In order to do this:

- 1) Create a project with FTP Service enabled the Touch Panel Network Dialog of the C-more Programming Software.



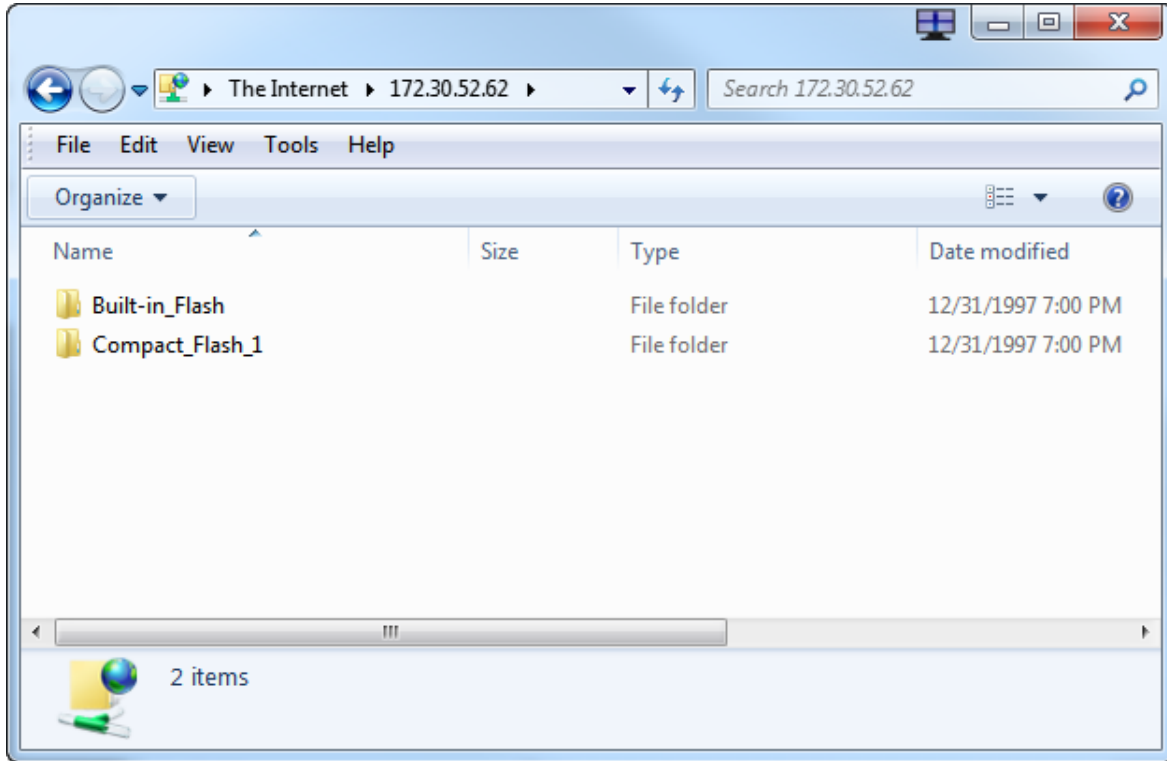
- 2) Download the Project to the C-more panel.
- 3) In an FTP Client such as Windows Explorer or Filezilla, enter the IP address of the C-more Panel.

4) Navigate to the "Built-in_Flash/root" folder as shown below.

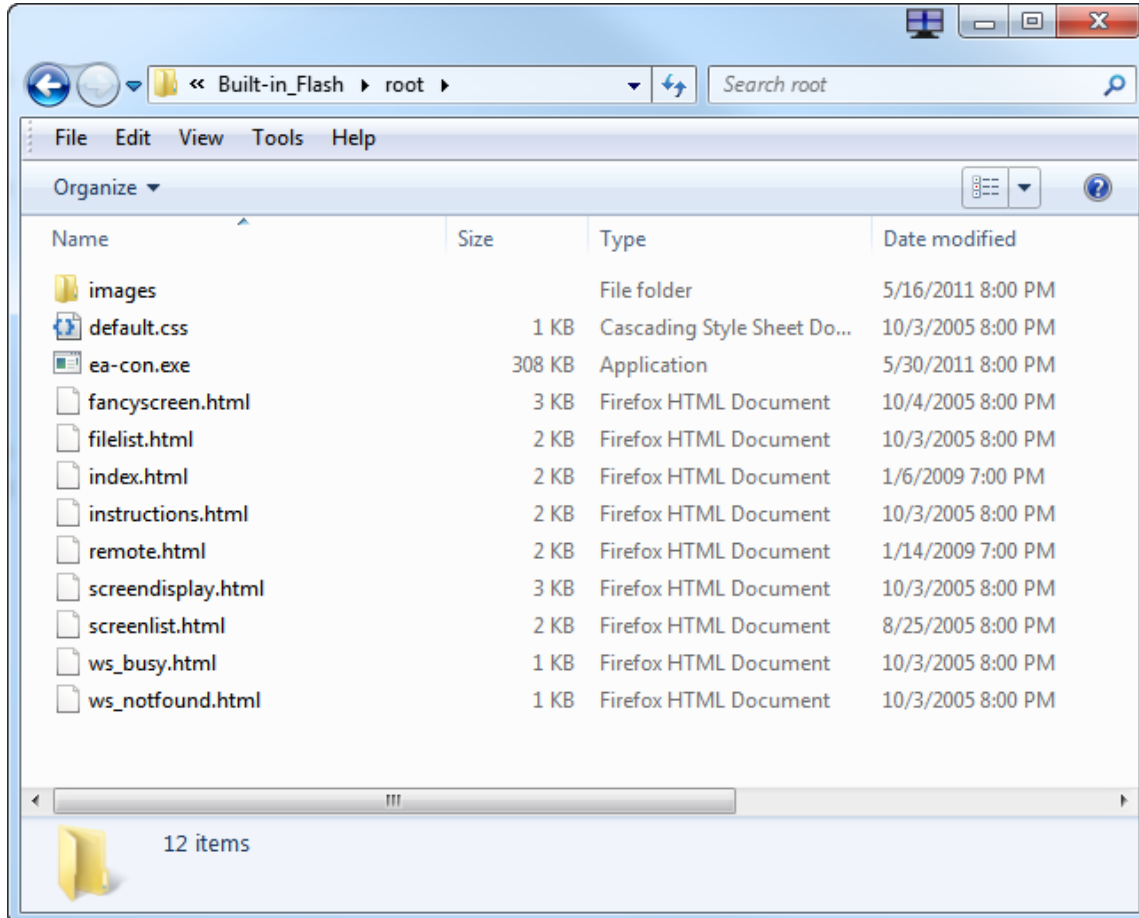

5) Copy the files you wish to edit and paste them on a local PC drive.

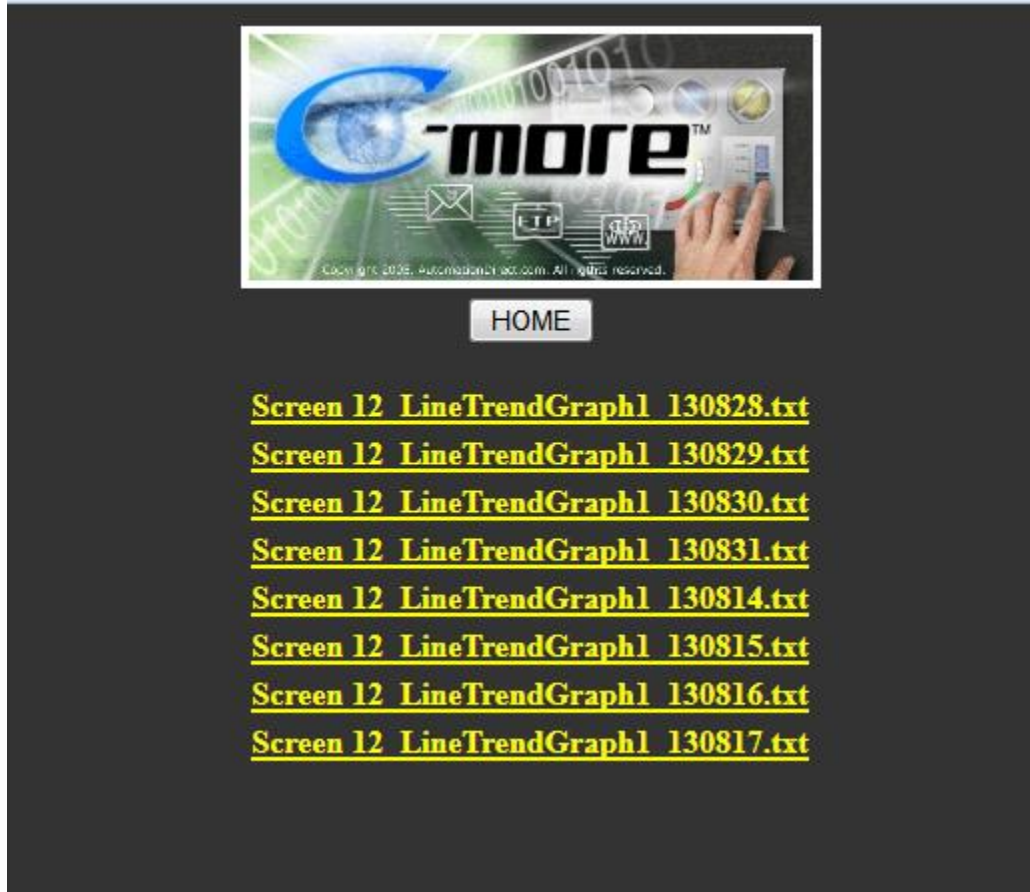

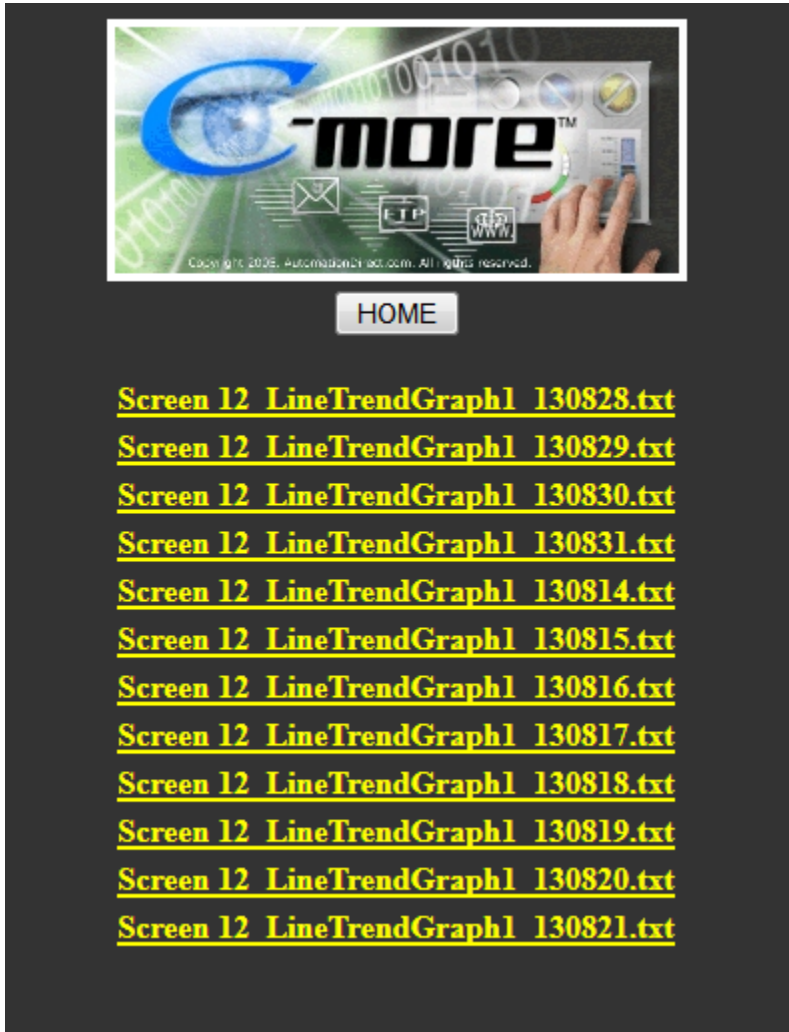
