

#### **Editing the HTML files in the C-more Panel**

In order to edit he HTML files in the C-more panel, the files must be copied from the panel to a local drive and edited with a Text Editor application like Notepad.

The files in the C-more Panel are accessed via FTP. In order to do this:

1) Create a project with FTP Service enabled the Touch Panel Network Dialog of the C-more Programming Software.




- 2) Download the Project to the C-more panel.
- 3) In an FTP Client such as Windows Explorer or Filezilla, enter the IP address of the C-more Panel.



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
4) Navigate to the "Built-in\_Flash/root" folder as shown below.





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
5) Copy the files you wish to edit and paste them on a local PC drive.





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#### Adding more files to the File List page



- 1) Access the C-more panel via FTP and copy the "filelist.html" file to your local drive and open using a text editor such as Notepad.
- 2) The File List is an HTML Table. To add more Files to the list (table) add more Table Row (<TR>) commands to the Table as shown below





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3) After making changes to the file, save it and copy and paste it back to "Built-in\_Flash/root" folder in the C-more Panel.





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#### Add more screens to the Screen Display page



1) Access the C-more panel via FTP and copy the "screendisplay.html" file to your local drive and open using a text editor such as Notepad.



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2) The Screen List is an dynamic HTML Table. To display more Screens in the list (table) adjust the "screenCount" variable as shown below.
