

- 4. To select the firmware image you wish to load, click the browse button and choose the appropriate file. The firmware file will have a .fwb extension. Enter the optional MD5 checksum in the appropriate box if desired. This value verifies the file has not been corrupted during transfer. You do not need to use an MD5 checksum unless your network administrator tells you to.
- 5. Click the **Install from file** button to begin the transfer. This process will take several minutes.
- 6. To make the newly loaded firmware the running firmware on the switch, click on Manage Firmware





- 7. Select the firmware version to be the default firmware running on the switch.
- 8. Reset or power cycle the switch.
